FEMA is looking for applicants from Texas, especially Austin and Houston, to fill anticipated openings as Reservist ADR Advisors who are on call to deploy as needed to disaster operations. Applicants should have 300 hours of conflict resolution skills training and five years of varied dispute resolution experience working with individuals and groups using individual listening and problem-solving, coaching, facilitation, mediation, and conflict resolution skills training. An advanced degree in conflict resolution may be substituted for 100 hours of training and two years of experience.

ADR Advisors need to be on call to travel within 72 hours for 60 days once or twice a year depending on the service level they choose. The ideal candidate has the ability to maintain themselves financially through their independent practice and the flexibility to quickly reschedule and make themselves available for a 60-day FEMA deployment on short notice.

Our need varies considerably because the number and scope of disasters declared cannot be predicted. Pay is approximately \$41/hour plus daily Per Diem for miscellaneous and incidental expenses when deployed away from home. Reservists qualify for the Federal Employees Health Benefits plan during their first disaster deployment and the government pays about 72% of the cost of premiums.
